## **Mark 14:27-50 – Jesus Knows, Shows and Goes**

### **Discussion Questions**

Pray for God's help as you turn to look at His word, to understand and respond rightly to what you'll see. Then read through Mark 14:27-50 carefully considering the words and their meaning.

1. The main points on Sunday were: (1) Jesus knows we're weak, (2) Jesus shows he's strong and (3) Jesus goes to die for us. Was there anything in particular you felt God was saying to you through this passage?
2. Do you think you are prone to underestimate your weakness in being able to live for Jesus? If so, how do you see this in your life?
3. How does Jesus encourage us to respond to the reality of our weakness and repeated failings (v38)? And what might this look like day-to-day?
4. In what ways is Jesus different from the disciples in this passage? Why should his 'strength' give us reassurance?
5. How are you going to respond to what we've seen?
6. How can we help each other, in the ways we speak, behave and pray, to have confidence not in ourselves, but in Jesus?
