Exodus 20-24 – Living in Light of the Law

Discussion Questions

Pray for God's help as you turn to look at His word, to understand and respond rightly to what you'll see.

1. Was there anything from Sunday's talk that stood out to you or was there anything you didn't understand and would like to discuss?
2. The law of God helps us to get to know the will and character of God. Suggest some things we learn about God from the 10 commandments (Ex. 20:1-17). How do these things cause you to love Him more?
3. The law of God exposes our sin. How do the 10 commandments make you more aware of your own sin? (It may help to notice how Jesus turns the focus of these laws from the outward behaviour to the internal heart-condition – see Matthew 5:21-22, 27-28.)
4. The law of God points us to Jesus. How did Jesus 'fulfil' the law, perhaps particularly those laws you are convicted of breaking?
5. What does it mean that Jesus fulfilled the law 'for me', the Christian? Describe how this can comfort us when we are convicted of our sins?
6. A friend says to you, "It's crazy to try to apply the Old Testament law to your life today!" How would you respond?
